Objectives of the Committee:

The committee is tasked with the responsibility of furthering the ideals of the UGC Regulation and any other laws put in place with regards to the menace of ragging by the Governments of India.

Functions of the Committee:

- To Prevent, Prohibit and Redress any and all forms and instances of Ragging in the College.
- To educate the students on the meaning of ragging and what constitutes it.
- To educate the students on the ill-effects of ragging and the consequences, including legal consequences of indulging in ragging.

- To conduct awareness programmes on the menace of ragging, its impact, consequences and redressal mechanism available.
- To enquire into any instances of ragging that have been reported, and if necessary, take all appropriate action against the students found to have indulged in ragging.
- Assist the Principal and other authorities of Apex Trust Nursing College and Apex Institute of Paramedical Sciences if necessary, in notifying the appropriate authorities in cases of ragging.
- To implement Zero tolerance policy in campus

ANTI-RAGGING

Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell & Anti-ragging Squad will monitor regularly for to ensure calm and peaceful academic atmosphere in the campus.

Students shall not:

- ✓ Violate the status, dignity and honor of girls' student.
- ✓ Violate the status dignity and honor of SC and ST student.
- ✓ Expose students to ridicule and contempt thereby affect their self-esteem.
- ✓ Entail verbal abuse and aggression indecent gesture and obscene behavior.

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

1. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
2. Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
4. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.

5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students
7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
9. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher

Punishment against misconduct or ragging

1. The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents. The student who is found to be indulged in ragging should be debarred from taking admission in any technical institution in India.
2. After every single incident of ragging, a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with local police authorities.
3. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti- Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishment for those who found guilty of ragging at the institution level. Those shall be any one or any combination of the following.
 - ✓ Cancellation of admission
 - ✓ Suspension from attending classes for a period of one month.
 - ✓ With holding withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits
 - ✓ Debarring from appearing in any college/University examination or any other evaluation process
 - ✓ Without holding results
 - ✓ Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - ✓ Suspension/expulsion from the hostel

- ✓ Rustication from the institutions for period ranging from 1 to 4 semester
- ✓ Character and conduct certificate of the college will be written poor/ in-obedient student.
- ✓ Imposing of penalty Rupees 25000/-

4. Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

5. The institutional authority shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council/ University immediately after occurrence of such incident and inform the status of the case from time to time. Courts should make an effort to ensure that cases involving ragging are taken up on
